What is Digital Orchestration?

Recreating the sound of a Symphony Orchestra, or any other – particularly acoustic – ensemble, presents a great challenge to the contemporary composer and digital musician. The latest sample libraries are better than ever but still require a great deal of skilled manipulation to convince listeners that they are listening to the "real thing".

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Payment

Once the final quote has been agreed a 20% deposit is required with the balance payable on completion of the project. Large projects will require staged payments.

Unless otherwise agreed it is assumed that all projects are carried out on a "Buy Out" basis with Kanon Digital Orchestration having no future claim on the project.

Ownership of the project remains with Kanon Digital Orchestration until full payment has been made.

Copyright

Clients must ascertain that they have copyright permission to use the music they are submitting. This is particularly important where the music submitted is an arrangement / reworking of music which is already in copyright. Of course, if you are submitting an original composition of your own, then copyright rests with you anyway.

- * When submitting files please include as much information as possible. Sibelius / Finale files should be edited as deeply as possible. Please make all "hidden commands" visible. Make sure metronome marks, tempo changes, dynamics etc. are entered with the correct commands so that they are accurately read by the midi sequencer. It is also a good idea to send a pdf file as well as the Sib / Fin file this helps to make sure that different versions of programs do not misread files. You may also wish to send some outline notes to help us follow your wishes as closely as possible.
- ** We can supply your project in a range of formats including: the original wav file { highest quality can be saved to DVD or transferred via e.g "we transfer", "Dropbox" etc}, CD quality, mp3 (various renderings), ogg vorbis etc.

We can also produce and duplicate CDs including labelling and printed inserts. No minimum quantity – we will supply one if that is all you need.
